**Important:** Final parade placement and staging details will be sent to registered participants. All entries must check in and follow directions from parade officials and public safety personnel. Please arrive with your entire group whenever possible.

### 8. PARADE RULES & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

#### Vehicles & Floats

- All motorized vehicles must be operated by a properly licensed driver and carry required insurance.
- Vehicles, floats, trailers, decorations, and equipment must be in safe operating condition.
- Participants may not enter or exit moving vehicles or floats while the parade is underway.
- Riders must remain safely positioned and may not ride on hitches, unsafe edges, or unsecured areas.

#### Children

- Children must be appropriately supervised by responsible adults at all times.
- Children may not ride in unsafe areas of vehicles, trailers, floats, or equipment.

#### Candy & Giveaways

- Candy may be thrown only underhand and toward the ground along the spectator edge of the route.
- Candy must never be thrown directly at people or into the path of moving parade entries.
- Spectators and children must remain out of the parade travel lane; walkers may hand items out at the route edge.

#### Animals

- Animals must be under the control of an experienced handler at all times.
- Animal entries are responsible for care, supervision, safety, and immediate cleanup.

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### 9. ADDITIONAL PARADE RULES

#### Alcohol, Drugs, Weapons & Dangerous Materials

- Alcohol, marijuana, illegal drugs, and impairment while participating are prohibited.
- Weapons, explosives, fireworks, open flames, and dangerous materials are prohibited unless specifically authorized.

#### Conduct & Parade Movement

- Participants must remain respectful, family-friendly, and follow parade official directions.
- Harassment, threatening behavior, dangerous conduct, or intentionally disruptive activity will not be permitted.
- Entries must maintain safe spacing and continuous forward movement unless instructed otherwise.
- Extended stops, performances, or demonstrations require advance approval.
- Parade officials may adjust entry placement, staging, spacing, or participation for safety and operations.

#### Political & Advocacy Entries

- Participation does not constitute endorsement by the event, fiscal sponsor, City of Bellevue, or partners.
- Candidates, campaigns, advocacy organizations, and issue groups must follow the same rules as all entries.

#### Participant Responsibilities

- Follow parade instructions and all applicable safety requirements.
- Accept responsibility for the conduct and safety of individuals participating with this entry.
- Maintain legally required insurance, licenses, and permits for vehicles, animals, equipment, or activities.
- Notify parade organizers if significant information changes after the application is submitted.
- Leave staging and parade areas clean and free of trash, animal waste, decorations, or debris.
